Prior to **November 12, 2020**, a copy of the Information Circular will be sent to you within three business days of receipt of your request. If you would like to receive a paper copy of the Information Circular before the proxy voting deadline of **9:30 a.m.** (**Toronto time**) on **November 10, 2020** if submitting a proxy by mail or fax or **12:00 p.m.** (**Toronto time**) on **November 12, 2020** if you are voting online or by telephone, you should take into account the three business day period for processing requests, as well as typical mailing times for first class mail suggested by Canada Post, and make your request prior to **November 10, 2020**.

You can also request a copy of the Information Circular up to one year after the date of this letter, and in which case, if we receive your request after **November 10**, **2020** then we will send it to you within 10 calendar days.

Please read the Information Circular carefully, as it has important information regarding the changes being proposed.
