

Fidelity for fixed income: Summary video

Sri Tella: What really differentiates Fidelity is that it has a proven, team-driven, consistent investment process that's proven to add value to our clients over time.

Kevin Nielsen: I think the real advantage that Fidelity fixed income has is the willingness to invest in research. Carrie Saint Louis: I feel very fortunate working in research at Fidelity; we have our global scale and strength. We all have a very sharp focus on trying to get the best risk-adjusted returns for our shareholders in our funds.

Michael Plage: Fidelity is a private company, so we're not beholden to shareholders on a quarterly basis, and when others are cutting back we're able to invest in our resources.

Catriona Martin: What you're going to get is a stable partner with a solid investment team that has a proven track record that they can deliver consistent risk-adjusted performance for clients.

Jeff Moore: When I look at the future of Fidelity, it's so bright – and I'm not sure exactly how things will all evolve, but it really won't matter, because we'll have all the building blocks and pieces to be successful.
